 **Why?** Our lab is leading a National Science Foundation funded research project to better understand how urbanization affects wildlife. We are interested in learning about how cities affect animals and if animals are adapting to the unique aspects of city living.

 **Where?** Our project will compare house mice that live in **Philadelphia, PA, New York City, NY, and Richmond, VA** to the mice that live in rural areas around those cities.

 **How do you collect the mice?** We set the traps in houses, apartments, stores, or other indoor areas. Our traps are similar to “have-a-heart” live traps and are designed to keep animals safe. We come back and collect the traps and take the mice with us.
